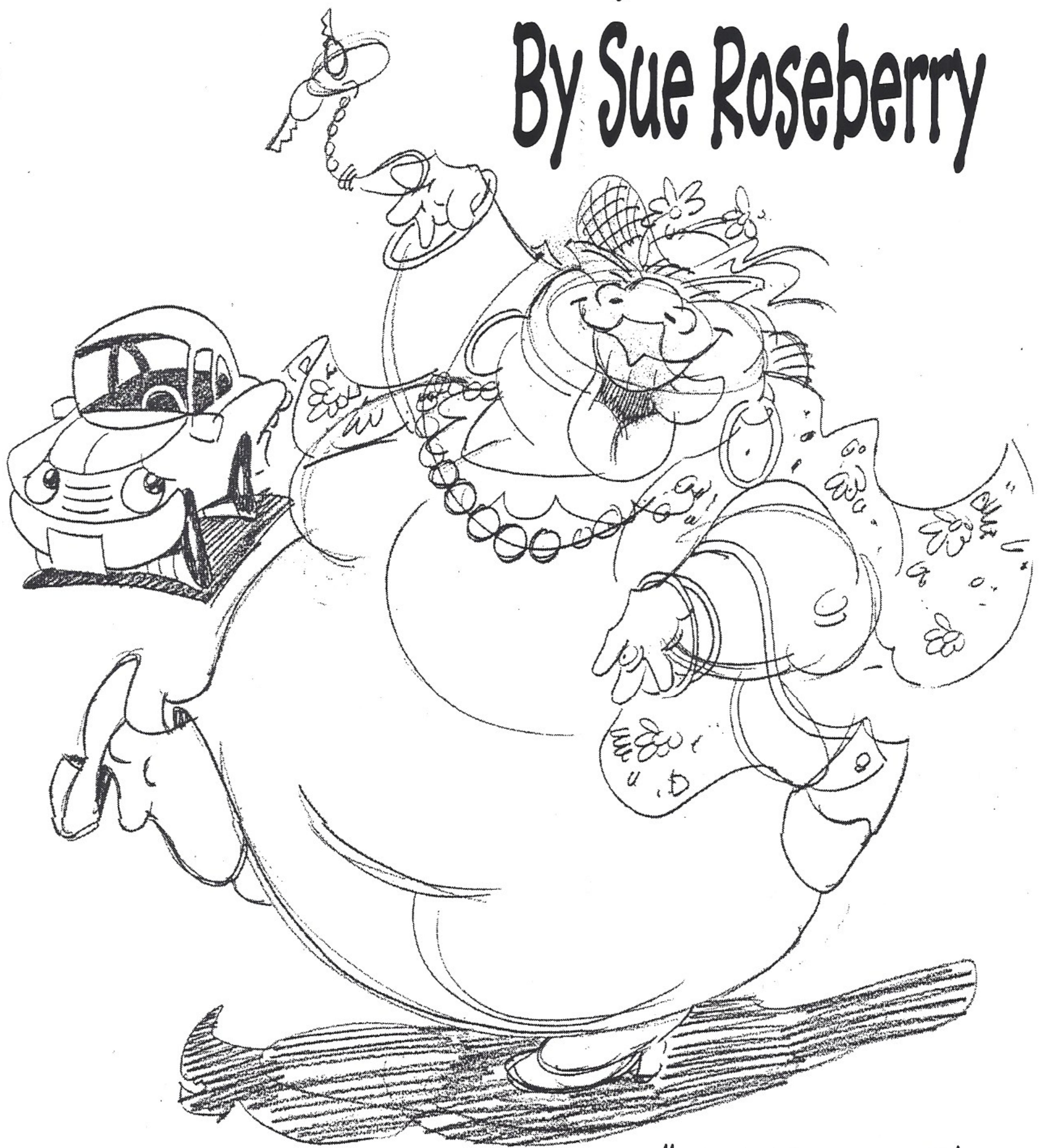


# Miss Annie From Way Down South

old Chevy out of the shed.

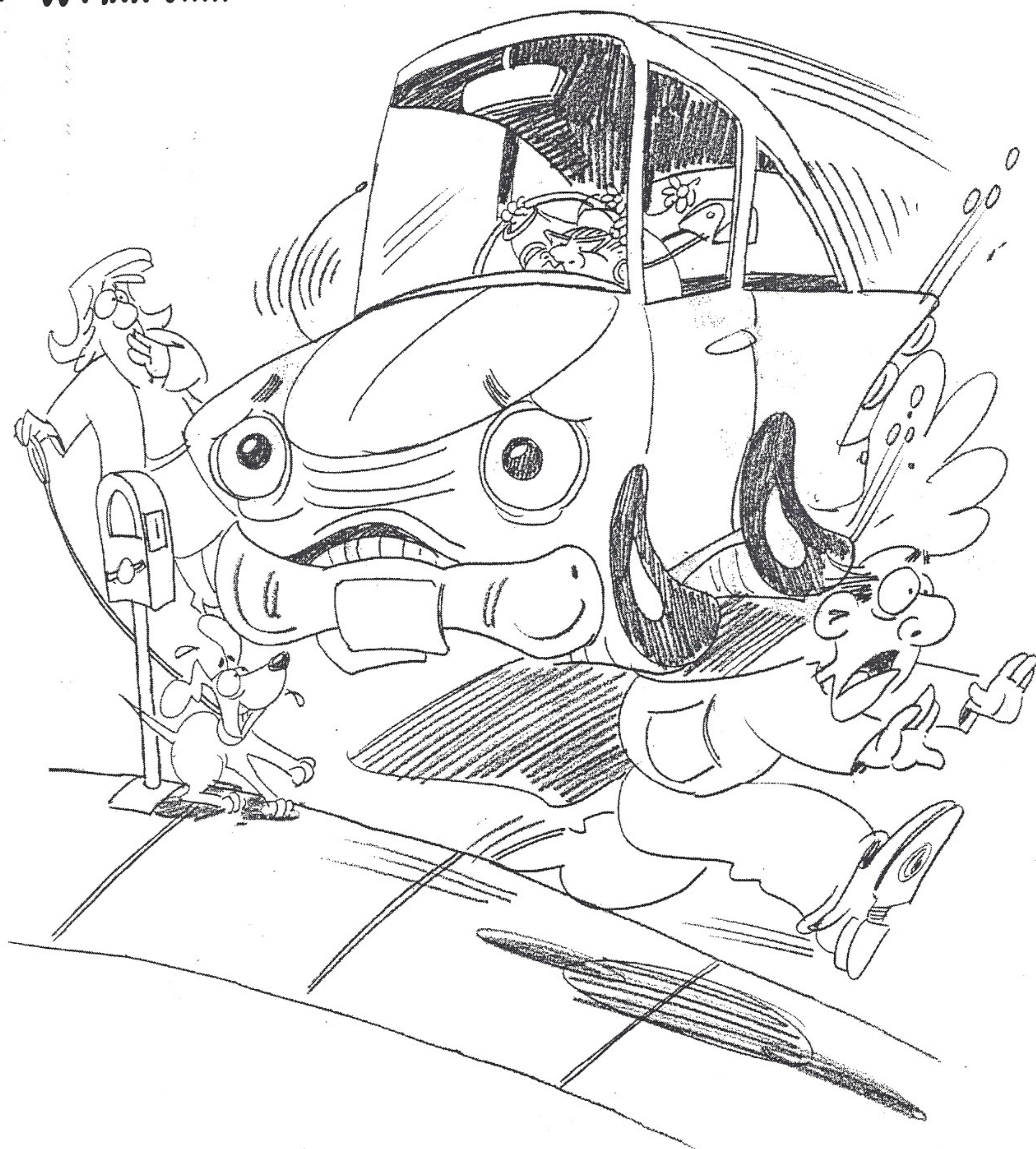
She'd put her purse on her arm and put her hat on her head.
